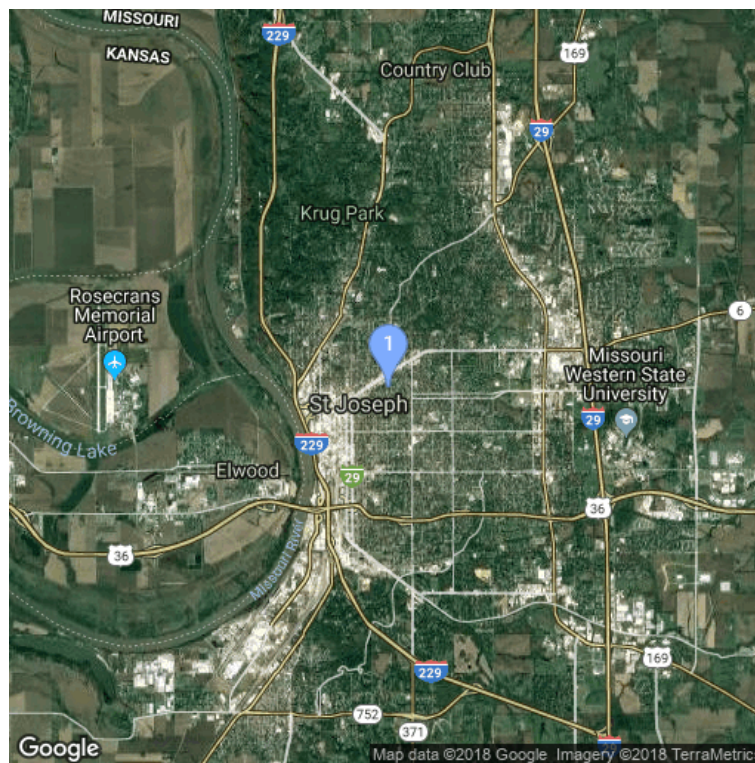

Through this plan the TCMP would be part of the larger network and coordinated with other site through the National Parks Authority. Additionally, a local NGO (SusGren) has recently facilitated the development of a formalized Grenadines Network of MPAs (including the TCMP, SIOBMPA, and MBMPA) in January 2011. The agreement signed among these sites fosters collaboration between the MPAs and their partner and information sharing on all aspects of MPA management

Personnel

While the staff management office is not located on-site, they are located on Union Island, which is approximately 20 minutes away by boat from the site. There are fifteen full time staff for the site which is close to 75% of that identified as needed for full site management. Site rangers are on the water daily. Other management staff are housed in the main office on Union Island and go to the site as needed.
